# TEN HOLIDAY WINES

## *under twenty dollars*



**GRAPE: CHARDONNAY**  
**REGION: MÂCONNAIS-BURGUNDY-FRANCE**

*white flowers, pineapple, lemon zest, bright minerality and light vanilla toast*

**GRAPE: SAUVIGNON BLANC**  
**REGION: SONOMA COUNTY - CALIFORNIA**

*pink grapefruit, melon & tropical fruits, orange blossom, bright acidity, and slight French oak notes*



**GRAPE: PINOT GRIS (PINOT GRIGIO IN ITALY)**  
**REGION: ALSACE - FRANCE**

*pear, honey, lemon, round bodied and soft mouthfeel add a complexity to your boring, old pinot grigio*

**GRAPES: GRENACHE-SYRAH-CINSAULT**  
**REGION: LANGUEDOC - FRANCE**

*crisp apple, cherry, watermelon, strawberry, roses, pink flowers, bright acidity with a slight earthiness*



**GRAPES: 73% CHARDONNAY - 26% PINOT NOIR - 1% PINOT MEUNIER**  
**REGION: NAPA VALLEY - CALIFORNIA**

*strawberry, raspberry, round marzipan effervescence - from one of the first French owned properties in California...they know their bubbles!*

**GRAPES: 45% CHARDONNAY - 45% PINOT NOIR - 10% PINOT GRIS & PINOT MEUNIER**  
**REGION: NAPA VALLEY - CALIFORNIA**

*lemon & lime zest, crisp apples, creamy vanilla and spice with racing acidity - G.H. Mumm established this property in Napa...they too, know their stuff!*



**GRAPE: TEMPRANILLO**  
**REGION: RIOJA - SPAIN**

*bright red cherries, spice and smokiness - to be called 'Reserva' this wine must be aged at LEAST three years, one of which in oak barrels*



**GRAPE: MERLOT**  
**REGION: COLUMBIA VALLEY - WASHINGTON STATE**

*jammy raspberries, black raspberry, cocoa, spice, balanced tannins - Pioneers in putting Washington State on the wine map*



**GRAPES: 92% CABERNET SAUVIGNON - 8% BORDEAUX VARIETALS**  
**REGION: SONOMA COUNTY - CALIFORNIA**

*blackberry, cherry, vanilla, mocha and a tannic structure  
The Jackson Family have been focusing efforts on sustainability and recommitting to production focusing on terrior driven wines*



**GRAPE: PINOT NOIR**  
**REGION: SONOMA COAST - CALIFORNIA**

*tart cranberry, strawberry, bigger & bolder California notes with French refinement, complexity and finish*
